Over the past two months our committee has been meeting through the use of email and phone. We have each asked for and received written comments from our respective classmates regarding their opinion of how the classes went this year. This was done not to judge the teachers in any way or make any decisions related to class placements. Everyone benefits from feedback and constructive criticism, both dancers and teachers.

We tried to get you going by providing a few sample questions to ask yourself, but we hoped that you would feel comfortable making some general comments. We received 18 responses and are thankful for your participation. These comments have been sent to the teacher representative for the Branch, and in turn she has shared them with the teachers.

A summary of general comments from all respondents were as follows:

- They were *happy with their respective teachers*. Smiles on the teacher's faces and the use of humour during classes were appreciated.
- They *love the social aspect of getting together*, learning new and sometimes more challenging dances, as well as listening and dancing to beautiful music.
- Speaking of listening, many comments were made regarding too much talking during classes and socials, and this was not directed at the teachers but at the participating dancers. Certainly we are a social group, but we are also there to learn. When the teacher is ready to start the teaching we need to be respectful of their time and efforts, both at classes and at socials, and "Zip it Up". The chance to chat is before and after each dance, not during.
- There were comments about *challenging dances*, however if you are attending the advanced class then this is what you might expect.
- Perhaps just a *little more instruction or demonstration* might help these individuals. Pushing, pulling and getting annoyed does not help. Remembering that *each class comes with widely varying abilities*.
- There were several comments about the *lack of technique being taught* in both the technique and basic classes.
- There were many comments about how *helpful it was to have more experienced* dancers in class to assist with newcomers.
- Several comments were made regarding *the helpfulness of repetition* when learning new dances and figures. Repeating that dance the same night or the following week is useful.
- Everyone *appreciates that all the teachers come prepared*, even to the point of having to change their teaching plan at the last minute when not enough dancers show up, uneven numbers to do a chosen dance, etc.
- We really appreciate their efforts in taking time to come out and give us the best instruction possible.

I want to thank the membership for responding in a respectful way. We are hoping you are staying healthy and we are looking forward to getting back to dancing in September. The teachers for the classes are usually announced at the AGM. Because the AGM has been postponed until further notice, the Committee will confer with the Teacher Rep and other members of the COM to decide when to make this announcement.
